Mission -- OPMG Policy and Plans Division leads long-range policy development, planning, integration and assessment which inform resource allocation, program management and PMG decision making.

Responsibilities and Programs

- Operationalizes the MP Force 2020 Strategic Plan (STRATPLAN)
- Executes the Operational Management Meeting (OMM) process
- Manages OPMG equities in Army cyclic planning requirements including:
 - Army Campaign Plan (ACP) input
 - Army Campaign Support Plan (ACSP) input
 - Army Force Generation/Regional Alignment of Forces (RAF) input
 - Army Posture Statement input
- Coordinates OPMG, Army, DoD policies for all roles and responsibilities of the PMG
- Maintains situational awareness of and appropriate participation in the HQDA G-3 Plans Process as well as Peacekeeping and Stability Operations Institute (PKSOI), Army Capabilities Integration Center (ARCIC), Security Force Assistance (SFA) working group and other OSD efforts affecting the MP Corps and Policing
- Fosters two-way support and communication with MP Corps Fellowship program participants
- Supervises academic and Joint, Interagency, Inter-governmental and Multi-national (JIIM) strategic outreach
- Coordinate review/input of NATO Standard Agreements

Initiatives

- Coordination with the Department of State to synchronization International Policing Standards
- Assisting in the development of Policy with OSD Security Force Assistance (SFA) Working Group for the synchronization of Transitional Policing efforts
- Developing DA Policy on Police and Correctional Internships
- Coordinating with several Federal and International Policing Agencies (i.e. INTERPOL) to develop Partnership and internship programs
- Staffing an updated OPMG publications priority list for use at The Army Publishing Agency
- Participating in HQDA, ARFORGEN, RAF, ACP and ACSP WGs to integrate PMG and MP STRATPLAN priorities and equities
- Integrating MPs into an ARSOF Advisory Detachment that will assist U.S. Army Special Forces with advising and assisting state and ministerial police and non-military internal security forces
- Working in conjunction with United States Office Special Warfare to develop MP Policy for the development of the New Army Doctrine on Stability Operations and Security Force assistance training
- Developing a Newsletter capturing the RAF contributions across the MP Corps
